2019 BREEDING SEASON

The 2019 Breeding Season is here and so is this year's **STAGBI STALLION DIRECTORY 2019** which includes updates on current stallions and details of new stallions licensed in 2018/19.

For your in-foal mares, you should by now have received your mating certificate from the stallion owner. Please note that there are **3 sections to the mating certificate**. The first section is retained by the stallion owner, the other two sections are handed to the owner of the mare. The smaller section should be **returned to STAGBI within 30 days of the birth of the foal**. The larger section should be returned to STAGBI when you are submitting the application for registration.

Applications to register 2019 foals should be received in the STAGBI office by 31st October (NB registration fees overleaf)

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP

ALL ANNUAL MEMBERSHIPS are due on the 1st April 2019.

Gold memberships are for 5 years, please check with office if you are unsure of renewal date.

Annual Membership £10 or Gold Membership £40 for 5 years. Please contact STAGBI office to renew your membership and remember you need to be a STAGBI member when making any transaction with STAGBI, to receive the newsletter and any of the Annual Awards & Premiums.

EQUINE INFLUENZA OUTBREAK

As the Newsletter goes to print, Equine Influenza (EI) has halted all Thoroughbred Racing in the UK. You can keep up to date with events by visiting the Animal Health Trust (AHT) website (www.aht.org.uk). Horse owners/trainers are expected to be vigilant to any signs of EI and **act responsibly** with regard to **vaccination, yard/stud biosecurity** and to **the travelling of horses**.

Young foals will be vulnerable to EI so it is important to give consideration to your broodmares and their vaccination status. The AHT is also recommending horse owners re-vaccinate their horse if their vaccination was carried out over 6 months ago, in order to maximise the chance of having protective immunity.

IRELAND

Please note that **ANY PASPORTS** posted to Ireland will incur an **additional postage fee of £10**. All other transactions will incur £5 additional postage fee. PAYMENTS can be made by cash, PO, cheques (payable to STAGBI) or BACS (contact STAGBI for bank details). Please note STAGBI **cannot accept** Euro Postal Orders.

Should anybody in Ireland wish to continue to receive the STAGBI newsletter, you can do so for a £20 fee. Please get in touch with STAGBI.

Reminder about your responsibilities as a horse owner as required by current EU & DEFRA regulation:

- **YOU** are required to register a foal within 6 months of birth or before 30st November of the year of birth (to meet this criteria STAGBI require that all registrations are received by STAGBI **before 31st October**)
- **YOU** are responsible for ensuring **ALL** your horses now have a microchip
- As a new owner **YOU** are required to **notify the PIO** of a change of ownership **within 30 days of purchasing** the horse.
- If you have imported a horse into the country **YOU** are required to register the horse **within 30 days of import** (this includes horses that have an existing passport that are imported from EU countries).
- **YOU** are responsible of **reporting the death of a horse within 30 days** and the **passport returned** to STAGBI within 30 days.

NEWS & NOTICES

❖ BREXIT

We are currently in a period of considerable uncertainty as to what will happen at the end of March 2019. It is likely that any implementation period following Brexit would see a temporary continuation of the current movement of horses between Britain, Ireland and mainland Europe until at least December 2020 with work proceeding on longer-term arrangements beyond any such period.

Under the EU Withdrawal Act 2018 the UK will leave the EU at 11pm on 29 March 2019. There is much discussion, debate and speculation surrounding the withdrawal. However, there are 2 outcomes that are most likely.

Transition

The current understanding is that the Agreement on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union, published on 25 November 2018, would allow the current arrangements for movement of animals to continue during this 'transition' period to at least 31 Dec 2020.

After the end of 2020, it is likely that the UK takes on EU third country status and currently recognised UK breed societies be considered as third country breed societies.

STAGBI has been preparing information for Welsh Government and DEFRA to be presented to the European Union. This will enable STAGBI to become listed by the Commission as a 'third country breeding body'. Without becoming listed, there may be issues with i) the equine passports already issued, ii) exporting pedigree horses to the EU and that they are registered in EU Studbooks. .

New arrangements will be required for the long term, particularly with the advent of the EU Animal Health Law in 2021.

No deal

The UK's EU Withdrawal Act 2018 ensures that in all scenarios the same rules and laws will apply the day before and after the withdrawal, with changes agreed over time by the UK Parliament. Therefore, for the equine industry in broad terms the rules and regulations relating to imports and activities from the EU to the UK will remain the same in the short term.

In the longer term, the EU has suggested they would apply *"regulation and tariffs at borders with the United Kingdom as a third country, including checks and controls for customs, sanitary and phytosanitary*

standards and verification of compliance with EU norms." Therefore, the rules and regulations relating to exports and activities from the UK to the EU will undergo significant change.

DEFRA are planning for the various scenarios including a 'no deal' with drawl with on-line guidance which can be found on the UK Government website (www.gov.uk) and follow link to 'import & export'.

Ireland

Whether you are located within the Republic of Ireland or the UK, it is recognised that the contiguous status within the island of Ireland may change, as will this status between the UK and Ireland. For horses, currently there is essentially no border, this will change depending on any arrangement between the UK and the EU. Such changes would also apply to horses transiting to or from Ireland and other EU states via the UK.

Movement of horses

Under existing regulation and agreement there is currently a free movement of horses between the UK & Ireland. All horses must travel with a valid Equine Passport.

Horses travelling to & from mainland Europe are required to travel with a valid Equine Passport/ID and either an Intra-Community Trade Animal Health Certificate (ITAHC) or veterinary attestation (health documents). It is not necessary for horses to travel via a Border Inspection Post (BIP).

Post Brexit as the UK would be a 'third country', an Export Health Certificate (EHC) would be required to move horses, on a permanent or temporary basis, to the EU. This is likely to require additional action from vets to confirm the absence of equine disease. The process would require more planning from the horse owner and could involve increased cost if additional blood tests are required estimated to be £200 – £500 depending on the 'third country' category the UK is placed in after leaving the EU. The EHC would replace the ITAHC currently required and horses entering the EU from UK would have to pass through a BIP in an EU member state.

The EU Animal Health Law

In April 2021 the EU's new Animal Health Law will come into force. A huge number of existing EU legal acts are being streamlined into a single law with simpler and clearer rules. This is a fundamental change that was supported by the UK as a member of the EU. This law will fundamentally impact disease control, animal identification, movement and

premises registration, and the secondary legislation to implement these details is currently being drafted. Whilst the UK will be leaving the EU, to continue trade with the EU the UK will either have to have some recognised equivalence with the EU new Animal Health Law or comply with its provisions for third countries. Conversely for the EU to trade to the UK, it will have to comply with existing UK legislation.

Whilst the UK will transpose all existing EU legislation in UK law before March 2019, it cannot transpose laws that have not yet been written. So, whilst the underlying animal health standards will not change, the way they are delivered will undoubtedly significantly change after April 2021.

❖ CHANGES TO DEFRA'S POLICY

DEFRA has introduced a number of changes to Equine ID Policy that will affect STAGBI as a Passport Issuing Organisation and you as a horse owner. If you fail to comply with the equine ID regulations, your local authority may serve a non-compliance notice which will give you a set period to comply or depending on the severity of the offence, you may receive a fixed monetary penalty. Offences include

1. Failing to produce a passport when requested by a vet or inspector
2. Possessing a passport but no horse
3. Possessing a horse when the passport is not in your name without an agreement (preferably a written contract) between the owner and the 'keeper' (person responsible)
4. Selling a horse and not handing over the passport
5. Transporting a horse without a passport
6. Owning a horse without a microchip

❖ STAGBI 2018 CENSUS

You will have received the STAGBI 2018 Census with the last newsletter. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO COMPLETE THE FORM AND SEND IT BACK TO STAGBI ASAP.**

❖ COMPULSORY MICROCHIPPING

As of July 2018 DEFRA have stated that **ALL HORSES MUST BE MICROCHIPPED**. STAGBI has been microchipping horses for 20 years, however it only became compulsory by DEFRA regulation in 2009. Your horse's microchip number should be recorded in its passport. Please check that all your horses have a microchip and that the microchip is recorded in the Passport. In order to assist you the enclosed list will indicate to you if your horse has a microchip and if the microchip is recorded with STAGBI. There will be some older STAGBI horses that will not have been

microchipped, if that is one of your horses then please contact STAGBI office for a microchip pack. If your horse has been microchipped and the microchip number has not been added to the passport, then please contact STAGBI office.

❖ E MAIL ADDRESS

❖ WELFARE OF HORSES at SALES

Following the Brightwells Standardbred Sale at Bulth Wells 2018, unfortunately it has been necessary to remind vendors that you have a responsibility to ensure that your horses have adequate food and water whilst at the sale.

It is also necessary to remind vendors and buyers that as per "Welfare of Horses Oat Market Order 1990" it is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN to separate a foal from its dam while at the sale or in leaving the sale.

❖ GDPR

The new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is an EU regulation on data protection and privacy for all individuals in the EU and the EEA. A copy of STAGBI's updated Privacy Policy was published in previous newsletter (Issue 72 & 73) and can be viewed on STAGBI's website.

❖ STAGBI YOUNG PERSON'S AWARD

This NEW Award is available to a Young STAGBI member (aged 17 – 25) who is seeking some financial assistance in order to pursue an activity that will enhance their knowledge and benefit their involvement in the Standardbred Breeding /Harness Racing Industry.

The award, up to £250 may be used towards a course, training, gaining experience or travel. Application forms are available through the STAGBI office or via website. Applicants will be required to outline the nature of the activity and why it would be of benefit to them, proof of expenses will be required and applicants will be required to provide feedback after the activity.

The first awards will be awarded in Spring/Summer 2019 and applications should be received by the STAGBI office by the 1st March 2019. Awards will also be made in the Autumn/Winter and those applications should be received by 1st Nov 2019. If you require any further details please contact STAGBI Office.

NEW REGISTRATIONS Dec 18 – Feb 19

Please note that when new registrations are received the passport is issued SUBJECT TO PARENTAL VERIFICATION (see notes page within equine passport). Should there be a subsequent issue with the DNA result or the Parental Verification has not been confirmed, then STAGBI will recall the passport

and suspend the registration until such time as the matter has been resolved.

In the case of Late Registrations (Registrations received after the year of birth), passports will not be issued until such time as Parental Verification by DNA has been confirmed. Please be aware that this can take up to 6 to 8 weeks.

FOALING: The foaling season is upon us and here's a quick checklist for your new foal

The first few hours

Sit, suck, stand and search

- ✓ Within seconds the foal should right itself and sit up on its sternum
- ✓ After 30 minutes the foal should start to thrust front legs forward and attempt to stand – may be awkward and fall frequently so ensure good deep bedding – preferably straw.
- ✓ 1 hour: Between 30–60 minutes foal should stand successfully and start to look for the mare's udder
- ✓ 2 hours: Successfully nurse 5-7 times an hour.
- ✓ 4 hours: Foal should have passed dark meconium, followed by soft, pale yellow milk faeces.
- ✓ 12 hours: Within 6–12 hours the foal should have passed urine
- ✓ 12–36 hours Vet check, tetanus antitoxin and blood test for IgG.

When to call for help. Immediate vet attention may be required if:

- The foal cannot be roused immediately at birth, or goes quiet after initial activity
- The foal is unable to stand and nurse – legs may be contracted or may not have coordination to do so.
- The foal has no suck reflex after 2 hours. Foals require colostrum within the first 6 hours for immunity and have limited energy stores.
- Milk is seen coming out of the nostrils – this may be associated with a cleft palate or laryngeal insufficiency.
- No meconium (dark faeces) seen after 6 hours, colts are particularly prone to this and may present with signs of colic or straining while they are trying to pass hard faeces.
- Mare will not allow the foal to suckle or has no milk.
- Mare has not passed placenta within 3 hours.
